Thursday, October 7th: Rendezvous Whitehall Creek, Annapolis

- Anchor in Whitehall Creek.

- We will have a kick-off gathering with Rum Keg and CCA bar at Chris and Susan Bell's home on Whitehall Creek.
- Look for CCA burgee on their dock in Whitehall Creek (WSW of red day mark "8"). Rum Keg and CCA Bar on their lawn at 1800 hours. Please bring an hors d'oeuvre to share with the group. Casual cruising attire. (Driving address below).

<u>Friday, October 8th: Sunny Neff Race to Key Bridge & Rendezvous at the Four Seasons / Harbor East Marina in Baltimore Harbor</u> —

- Reset of the canceled Sunny Neff Race (Spring Race). Start at "R-92" (or green can #1 or thereabouts...near the Bay Bridge...race instructions will be provided) finish just short of the Key Bridge (+/- 17 NM).
- We have slips reserved on the Long dock at Harbor East Marina. This is a secure marina in a great and exciting part of downtown Baltimore surrounded by restaurants, shops and corporate offices and just a short two block walk to the newest and largest Whole Foods store in the US, Baltimore's famous Little Italy and Historic Fells Point. There is no need to make individual slip reservations as we have reserved room for at least 20 boats. The marina charges Slip fees are \$3.00 per foot charged to each boat individually and there will be no charge unless you show up.
- After arriving on Friday, we will take a water taxi ride to the General Ship Repair
 Corporation Yard. We will be hosted for a behind the scenes tour of this impressive
 facility by Derick Lynch whose family has owned the facility since 1924. Details will be
 provided.
- After returning from the Ship Yard Tour, we will gather for a group dinner in a private room with outside balcony at Café Gia Italian Restaurant (a short walk from the marina).
 Our dinner reservations are at 7pm. Dinner will be a three course Italian dinner (plus cash bar).

<u>Saturday, October 9th: Robert Goldsborough Henry, Jr. Race to Eastern Shore – Crab Feast</u> Dinner in Rock Hall.

- We will run the traditional Fall race on Saturday from Baltimore to The entrance to the Chester River. Instructions to be provided.
- The fleet will anchor in Grey's Inn Creek just off of the Chester River. The anchorage will be near the Greys Inn Creek Marina. We will have access to the marina dock for shore access via individual dingy.
- We have arranged access to the Grey's Inn Creek Marina where the Nellie Crocket will be tied up to provide a venue for a BYO cocktail gathering before dinner. Following the cocktail gathering, we have transportation arranged to take us on a 10-minute ride to Waterman's Crab House in Rock Hall for a crab feast under their outdoor waterfront tent.

There will be several additional choices for dinner in addition to crabs as well as traditional crab feast sides dishes (cash bar at the restaurant).

We have reserved the T-Head at The Grey's Inn Creek Marina for Nellie Crocket. The marina may have one or two (or none) additional slips available for our fleet depending on slip holders usage that weekend. We will try and let you know what might be available as the date approaches.
