## Proposed Itinerary

**Saturday Jan 24:** Arrive Argyle Int'l Airport, St. Vincent. Taxi to Blue Lagoon Marina (Moorings, Charter) or Barefoot Yacht Charter, about 5 miles south of the airport.

Begin check-in, with charter companies. Barefoot Yacht Charter, Hotel and Marina, Blue Lagoon. Moorings, lodging, and dinner also available. Marissa Barnard +1 (784) 491-1444

**Sunday Jan 25:** Depart St. Vincent for Admiralty Bay, Bequia (10 miles). Big anchorage, moorings available. Check out Port Elizabeth and Belmont Walkway.

**1730**      Opening Dinner at Bequia Plantation.

**Monday Jan 26:** Lay Day in Bequia. Activities: 2 Dive shops, hiking, whaling museum, island tour via taxi, rum shop tour (by arrangement). Port Elizabeth has 4 food markets, vegetable/fruit stands, ice/water/fuel delivered to boat. Many good restaurants and beach bars in the harbor and around the island.

**Tuesday Jan 27:** Captains Choice. Suggestions - stop at Petit Nevis for swim and lunch, spend night in bight at Isle a Quatre, or sail to Mustique (8 miles). On Mustique...Basil's Bar, open for lunch and dinner. The Mustique Blues Festival will have music at Basil's on the 27th. Other: Cotton House for lunch of dinner (by reservation), island tour (two taxis on island), swim/snorkel with turtles in the harbor.

**1500 – 1800**      Cocktails Sleeping Dragon Villa, Mustique hosted by Paul Ford.

**Wednesday Jan 28:** Captains Choice. Head south for Canouan or Salt Whistle Bay, Mayreau (21 miles); or Tobago Cays (22 miles)

**Thursday Jan 29:** Lay Day at Tobago Cays; snorkel, swim with turtles, hike, beach on Petit Rameau.

**1730**      Rum Keg and Lobster Bake on Petit Rameau

**Friday Jan 30:** Clear out of SVG at Clifton, Union Island (4 miles) Time for our boats to be set, then sail to Chatham Bay (8 miles) on leeward side of Union Island

**Saturday Jan 31:** Suggested; sail to Carriacou, lunch stop at Sandy Island (9 miles), anchor down in Tyrell Bay (4 miles). Customs - Time for our boats to be set. Nearby restaurants, dive shop, etc in Tyrell Bay.

**Sunday Feb 1:** Carriacou to Grenada Underwater Sculpture Park (33 miles). Moorings available or anchor in 20' 40' feet. Snorkel reef along north side of bay. Informal fun race Carriacou to Grenada, your handicap will be an allowance for engine time.

**Monday Feb 2:** Suggested: Sail around bottom of Grenada to south shore bays

**0900** Grenada Chart and Safety briefing, Grenada YC, St Georges.

**Tuesday Feb 3:** Cruise south shore bays; True Blue, Prickly, Mt. Hartman, Woburn.

**Wednesday Feb 4:** Beach, Morne Rouge Bay, just south of Quarantine point. Anchor out in 10-15 foot depth, or taxi from where the boat is.

**1200** Beach BBQ lunch and Rum Keg.

**Feb 5:** Cruise south shore bays; True Blue, Prickly, Mt. Hartman, Woburn etc.

**Feb 6:** Closing dinner

**1730** The Aquarium, St. George's,

**Feb7:** Turn in boats; Fly out, Maurice Bishop Airport
