ARABELLA'S LANDING is a small marina with just eleven guest slips, which we have on hold. More slips might be available as permanent slip holders go cruising.

To book and pay for your slip:

Go to Arabella's Landing Marina website - www.arabellaslanding.com

1. Near the top, click tab "Book Reservations."
2. Next screen, click red box "Book Reservations."
3. Select Date(s) – You can not change dates later in booking process. Just below the date field, enter the code, **ccaycmay2026**, all lower case, no spaces.
4. Click blue box "Check Availability."
5. Select your slip size and preferred tie up side.
6. Follow the remaining prompts to input your personal and boat information, and pay. You will receive a confirming email which includes Additional information: Confirmation number, Door codes for Marina's main gate, restrooms, showers, and WiFi access details. Done!

Payment: 100% of moorage cost is due at time of booking.

Cancellations: Must cancel by the date in the slip confirmation email to receive a refund for the entirety of the reservation period, less \$10.00 processing fee.

Gig Harbor is also a large, safe anchorage. First come city dock and Seattle Yacht Club outstation is also available.
